There are 4 family hubs in Bradford (Bradford West, Bradford East, Bradford South and Keighley and Shipley) that can provide a range of services and support to families.

These family hub teams will be responsible for:

- early childhood development and school readiness
- · children's centres for children under five and their families
- targeted work with individual children and families (Families First)
- parenting support through all age ranges (children aged from birth to 19 or 25 with a disability)
- · family and maternal health and mental health
- · early education and free childcare
- · education attendance
- providing positive activities for young people
- · health and wellbeing
- · diversity and cohesion
