

Full Equipment

Full equipment is one of our 6 learning habits. It is important that students arrive to lessons with the right equipment, so that no learning time is interrupted. Students do this without carrying bags, this reduces wasted time packing and unpacking at the start and end of each lesson.

As part of our daily routine, equipment is checked every period 1. Students must have the following equipment displayed on the slide:



1. Knowledge organiser folder (Year 7 and 8 have printed copies)
2. Student planner
3. Age-appropriate reading book (this should not be the text students are reading in English)
4. Mini whiteboard
5. Mini whiteboard pen
6. Mini whiteboard rubber
7. Lunch card
8. Lanyard
9. Locker key
10. Pencil case
11. Green pen
12. Pen (blue or black)
13. Pencil
14. Yellow highlighter
15. Glue stick
16. Rubber
17. Sharpener
18. Ruler
19. Protractor
20. Scientific Calculator (Casio brand)

It is also an expectation that students carry the right exercise books/booklets, homework books and textbooks (where relevant) to every lesson. If any items contain graffiti (for example student planner, lunch card), students will need to replace this.

Students should do the following:

- Pack their school bag the night before to check they have the correct exercise books and daily equipment.
- Replace any equipment that is damaged or not working before period 1 the next day.
- Arrive no later to school than 07:50 to ensure they have time to go to their locker and organise their equipment before morning meeting or line up.
- Visit the equipment shop before 08:00 to replace equipment that is missing.
