Industrial action by the National Education Union (NEU)

Dear families,

As some of you may be aware, one of the teaching unions, the National Education Union (NEU), is planning strike action again this month. This is a national strike regarding a dispute between unions and the government over teachers' pay.

The NEU has given notice to us that strikes will impact Dixons Kings Academy on 15 March and 16 March 2023. Discussions are ongoing between unions and the government. Further strike action could be a possibility in the future.

Having considered the number of teachers at school who are members of the NEU, I have made the difficult decision to partially close the school on these dates. School will remain open for all students in Year 11 who have GCSE's and mock exams this year and those who have enhanced support. It is vital that all Year 11 attend on this day to support their revision and preparation. We will confirm directly with those families whose children will be able to attend school.

We have decided to restrict access in this way to ensure that we can provide an appropriate level of supervision and ensure the health, safety, and wellbeing of those in school.

For those children not in school, work will be set on teams for students to access. All students accounts have been reset and they will have access to their 365 accounts from home. Any student unable to access work online needs to make school aware.

If there are changes to our plan for responding to the proposed industrial action, I will advise you as soon as possible.

We wanted to communicate as soon as possible so you can plan accordingly. Thank you, as always, for your patience and understanding.
