Year 11 GCSE Examinations

As you will be aware from my previous communication on 6 May, Year 11 Study leave begins on Monday 30 May after this date students will only be required to come into the Academy when they have an exam or for an intervention session. Once study leave commences if students are not in an exam or an intervention session they must not be on site, this also includes if they have a morning and afternoon examination on the same day.

For all morning examinations, students should arrive at the academy and in uniform with all their equipment via their usual entrance by 8.00am. Before each exam there will be a briefing covering key topics and exam skills. Mobile phones and watches will be collected at the start of each exam, however I would like to advise that students leave their mobile phones and watches at home to avoid wasting time at the start and end of exams.

For the majority of exams taking place in the afternoon students should arrive at the academy by 1.30pm via reception. The exceptions to this are the exams listed below where students should arrive at the times below

- Arabic Writing exam on Monday 06 June - students to arrive at 12:45.
- Business Paper 2 exam on Monday 13 June - students to arrive at 12:00.
- Polish listening and reading exam on Friday 17 June – Students to arrive at 12:45.
- Further Maths on Wednesday 08 June 2022 and Wednesday 22 June - students to arrive at 12:30

The academy will be holding some additional revision sessions as detailed below to support students' preparation for the GCSE examinations. The focus of these sessions will be to support students and to help them to achieve the best possible grade in the forthcoming examinations. This is an ideal opportunity for many of our students to gain more practice in examination technique and benefit from the extra support to build confidence. Please discuss the sessions with your child and decide which ones would be most appropriate for them to attend. The sessions are optional; however, we highly recommended students attend so they benefit from the extra support.
