Year 11 GCSE Examinations

Year 11 students will finish their formal lessons on Friday 27 May and study leave will begin on Monday 30 May. Study leave is granted to allow our students to independently prepare for the upcoming examinations at home. All students should have prepared a revision timetable and it is vital they follow this and use their study leave time effectively.

The current afterschool intervention cycle will end on Friday 13 May. After this date, there will be some additional revision sessions as detailed below to support students' preparation for the GCSE examinations. The focus of these sessions will be to support students and to help them to achieve the best possible grade in the forthcoming examinations. This is an ideal opportunity for many of our students to gain more practice in examination technique and benefit from the extra support to build confidence. Once study leave commences if students are not in an exam or an intervention session they must not be on site.

Once study leave commences, students wanting to attend a revision session should arrive via the main reception doors 10 minutes before the scheduled start time with all their equipment and in their Academy uniform. Punctuality is extremely important and any students arriving late will not be able to attend the session. If students choose to attend a session, they must stay for the duration of it.



GCSE results are released to students on Thursday 25th August from 9am. We would love to see all our students in school receiving their results. It is a joyous occasion in school and we hope we can see your child there.
